In his pre-show interviews leading up to the **May 9, 2026**, show at **The Birchmere**, Kurt Neumann focused on the milestone of the band's 40th anniversary and the personal toll and reward of a lifetime on the road. [T](#) TysonsToday +1

### Key Interview Highlights

- **The "Never Too Old" Reflection:** Neumann poignantly recalled his 1979 high school yearbook quote, "**never too old to rock 'n' roll**". After 40 years of sleeping in bad hotels and jumping off drum risers, he admitted he's "starting to feel every mile" but remains motivated by the "positive and creative" purpose of the journey.
- **A "Full-Scale Celebration":** He explained that the decision to play **two-hour sets** (instead of standard festival sets) was specifically to cram in as many songs as possible from their 14 studio albums while still playing "all the favorites".

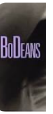

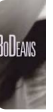
